The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to a Massachusetts Boston Strong license plate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 2E of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (c) the following subsection:-
- 3 (d) The registrar shall furnish, upon application, to the owners of private passenger motor 4 vehicles distinctive registration plates which shall display on the face a design indicating support
- 5 for the One Fund Boston helping the people most affected by the tragic events that occurred in
- 6 Boston on April 15, 2013 with the words "Boston Strong". There shall be a fee of not less than
- 7 \$50 for such plates in addition to the established registration fee for private passenger motor
- 8 vehicles, which shall be payable at the time of registration of the vehicle and at each renewal
- 9 thereof. One "Boston Strong" license plate may be issued free of charge to the parent, child,
- 10 sibling or spouse of a family member killed or severely injured as a result of the events on or
- 11 related to April 15, 2013. The portion of the total fee remaining after the deduction of costs
- 12 directly attributable to the issuance of such plates shall be directed to the One Fund Boston.
