**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to out of state citations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the definition of “Bus or motor bus” the
3 following new definition:- “Careless driving”, a person who drives a vehicle carelessly, or
4 without due caution and circumspection, in a manner so as to endanger, or be likely to endanger,
5 a person or property.

6 SECTION 2. Said chapter is hereby amended by adding the following new section at the
7 end thereof:-

8 Section 63: Citation Parity

9 The registrar shall provide parity with out of state citations processed in Massachusetts
10 including, but not limited to, careless driving citations, speeding citations, and expired
11 registration citations.
