## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act increasing grants and scholarships for public higher education students .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 16 of Chapter 15A of the General Laws is hereby amended in the second paragraph by

2 striking the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following new sentence:-

3 The amount of awards to qualified students shall be determined by using an indexing system

4 which shall be included in the guidelines established by the council to govern this program;

5 provided, however, that in no case shall the total amount of awards to students attending

6 independent colleges, universities, schools of nursing or any other programs in non-public

7 institutions of higher education exceed in any year the total amount of awards to students

8 attending public higher education institutions in the commonwealth.
