AN ACT AUTHORIZING INCREASED FEES FOR SPECIAL DETAILS PERFORMED BY PUBLIC EMPLOYEES IN THE CITY OF MEDFORD

.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1.
- 2 Notwithstanding section 53C of Chapter 44 of the General Laws or the provisions of any general
- 3 law, special law or regulation to the contrary, the City of Medford may impose a fee not to
- 4 exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the cost to the City of Medford for services performed by its
- 5 employees on off-duty work details which are related to the employee's regular employment or
- 6 for special detail work performed by persons where the detail is not related to regular
- 7 employment.
- 8 Section 2

9 The fee imposed under Section 1 may be increased by an additional fifteen (15 %) of the cost to
10 the City of Medford as described in said Section 1 if it is not paid within twenty-one (21) days of
11 the date that the initial fee becomes due and payable to the City of Medford.

12 Section 3

13 This act shall take effect upon its passage and shall be effective during the present fiscal year.
