# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts 

## In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to the granting of a club license for the sale of alcoholic beverages in the Town of Lincoln.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 17 of said chapter 138 of the general laws,
2 or of any other general or special law to the contrary, the board of selectmen of the town of

3 Lincoln may grant to The Groves a club license to sell all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the
4 premises at 17 Cambridge Turnpike in said town under section 12 of said chapter 138. The
5 license shall be subject to all of said chapter 138 except for said section 17, and to any
6 regulations and guidelines adopted by the Massachusetts Alcoholic Beverages Control
7 Commission relative to the service of alcoholic beverages.

8 The board of selectmen shall not approve the transfer of the license to any other location but the
9 license may be granted by the board of selectmen at the same location if an applicant for the
10 license files with the board of selectmen a letter in writing from the department of revenue

11 indicating that the license is in good standing with the department and that all applicable taxes 12 have been paid. If the license granted under this section is cancelled, revoked or no longer in

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.
