In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act providing for prisoners of war.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph 2 of subsection (a) of section 2 of chapter 62 of the General

2 Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following

3 subparagraph:-

(R) income received by a prisoner of war, defined as a person having been regularly
appointed, enrolled, enlisted or inducted into the military forces of the United States and having
been captured, separated and incarcerated by an enemy of the United States during an armed
conflict; and provided further, that the exemption pursuant to this paragraph shall be allowed for

8 the lifetime of the prisoner of war.
