## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act promoting personal access of driving records.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 1A of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:- The registrar shall make
- 3 a person's driving records available online for informational purposes. Such records shall be
- 4 considered unattested and need not be certified with the signature of the registrar, but shall
- 5 include any suspensions, outstanding tickets or other citations issued to the driver. Such records
- 6 shall be updated regularly to reflect the most accurate information available, consistent with the
- 7 way in which attested driving records are maintained for law enforcement agencies.
