## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act establishing a cultural highway.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 132A of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
- 2 Section 19. There is hereby established along state highway route 62 in the towns of
- 3 Hudson, Berlin, Clinton, Sterling and Princeton, a cultural highway, which shall ensure the
- 4 preservation of the economic, cultural, historical, agricultural and scenic aspects unique to the
- 5 route and its host municipalities. The secretary of energy and environmental affairs shall
- 6 establish the exact meets and bounds of the cultural highway and shall develop a program to
- 7 protect those resources within the cultural highway. Such program may include, but is not
- 8 limited to, the implementation of conservation restrictions, preservation restrictions, agricultural
- 9 preservation restrictions, watershed preservation restrictions, and the establishment of historical
- 10 districts.
