## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO CREDITABLE SERVICE ..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding chapter 32 of the General Laws, or any other general or special

2 law to the contrary, the Massachusetts Teachers' Retirement System shall credit Kathleen E.

3 Harvey with one total year of service she rendered between 1965 and 1969 while working at

4 Framingham State College, for the purpose of calculating a retirement allowance pursuant to

5 chapter 32. Eligibility for the creditable service shall be conditioned upon payment to the

6 Massachusetts Teachers' Retirement System of an amount equal to the contributions she would

7 have otherwise paid into the retirement system for the period of service together with regular

8 interest thereon. The repayment shall be made in one sum or in installments as the

9 Massachusetts Teachers' Retirement System shall prescribe.
