In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act of a petitioner to provide remuneration for an epidemiological base-line impact study.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The department of environmental protection under its operating permit and compliance
- 2 program (310 CMR 7.00: Appendix C) may not issue an operating permit unless the applicant
- 3 for an operating permit provides funding for an impact study done by an independent
- 4 epidemiologist retained by and chosen by a majority vote of the host community's city council or
- 5 board of selectmen.
