#### Abstract

An Act creating a maximum allowable check-cashing rate.. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:


1 SECTION 1. Chapter 169A of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding after section 13
2 the following section:

3 Section 14. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of the law to the contrary, no check-casher
4 licensed or subject to regulation under this chapter shall directly or indirectly charge or collect
5 fees or other considerations for rendering currency exchange services in excess of the following:

6 (1) 10 per cent of the face value of a personal check plus a service charge of one dollar.

7 (2) 3 per cent of the face value of a government check plus a service charge of one dollar.

8 (3) 3 per cent of the face value of a payroll check 100 dollars or less; 2.6 per cent of the face
9 value of a payroll check greater than 100 dollars

10 (4) 3 per cent of the face value of any other check, draft or money order including, but not 11 limited to, traveler's check, cashier's check, and certified check, plus a service charge of one 12 dollar.

13 SECTION 2. Section 8 of said chapter 169A is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 20 to 21 , 14 the words "five hundred dollars per day" and inserting in place thereof the following words: 15 one thousand dollars

16 SECTION 3. Section 13 of said chapter 169A is hereby amended by striking out, in line 2 , the
17 words "five hundred" and inserting in place thereof the following words: - one thousand

18 SECTION 4. Said section 13 of said chapter 169A is hereby further amended by striking out, in
19 line 4, the words "day a violation continues" and inserting in place thereof the following word: -
20 violation
