**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to certain elections by the city council in the city of Lawrence.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3.6 of chapter 425 of the acts of 1983 is hereby amended by  
2 striking out paragraph (a) and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:-

3           (a) Election. The city council shall elect a city clerk and a city attorney, who shall serve  
4 until their successors are qualified. The city council may remove any of said officials by a 2/3  
5 majority vote of the full city council. All removals from said office shall be accompanied by a  
6 statement of the reason or reasons therefore and filed in the office of the city clerk.

7           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
