Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. SECTION 1. Section 12CC of Chapter 112 of the General Laws, as

3 following sentence:-

4 For the purpose of this section the word "reasonable fee" shall mean a fee of not more that
5 twenty five cents per page of records, and not more than twenty dollars per hour for clerical and 6 administrative expenses.

7 SECTION 2. Section 70 of Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1998 Official
8 Edition is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:-

9 For the purpose of this section the word "reasonable fee" shall mean a fee of not more that
