**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to state job postings.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 30 of chapter 7 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3 Every agency and institution of the commonwealth shall transmit to the human resources
4 division all employment opportunities, notices, and postings, except positions subject to section
5 46D of chapter 30 and chapters 31 and 150E, including, but not limited to, notices of job
6 opportunities, new positions and vacancies. The division shall immediately place all such
7 information in the statewide employment computerized referral system.
