By Representative Fernandes of Milford and Senator Fattman, a joint petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3634) of John V. Fernandes (by vote of the town) that the town of Milford be authorized to establish a municipal finance department for said town. Municipalities and Regional Government. [Local Approval Received.]

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act authorizing a municipal finance department for the town of Milford.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. There shall be a department of municipal finance which shall be responsible
- 2 for the performance of all fiscal and financial activities of the town, including those duties and
- 3 responsibilities related to municipal finance activities which prior to the effective date of this act
- 4 were performed by or under the authority of the town accountant, town treasurer and tax
- 5 collector. Although the board of assessors shall be part of the department of municipal finance,
- 6 the board of assessors shall continue to exercise all of the duties and responsibilities of a board of
- 7 assessors under the General Laws, except as otherwise provided in section 3 of this act. The
- 8 department of municipal finance shall have such additional powers, duties and responsibilities
- 9 with respect to municipal finance-related functions and activities as the town may from time to
- 10 time provide by by-law.
- SECTION 2. The department of municipal finance shall be under the direct control and
- 12 supervision of a director of municipal finance who shall be appointed by and be responsible to

the Board of Selectmen, upon the recommendation of the town administrator. The director of municipal finance shall be a person especially fitted by education, experience and training to 14 perform the duties of the office. The educational qualifications shall consist of an advanced 15 degree, preferably in accounting or business administration, granted by an accredited degree-16 granting college or university. The professional experience shall include at least 3 years of prior 17 18 full time compensated service in accounting or business administration. Alternatively, 5 years or more of such professional experience and a bachelor's degree in an appropriate discipline shall 19 qualify an applicant. Five years or more of prior full time compensated experience in accounting 20 21 or business administration shall also qualify any applicant. The board of selectmen may waive the education or experience requirements of this section. The salary, fringe benefits and other 22 23 conditions of employment of the director of municipal finance, including but not limited to, severance pay, relocation expenses, reimbursement for expenses incurred in the performance of his duties or office, liability insurance, conditions of discipline, termination, dismissal, 25 26 reappointment, performance standards and leave may be established by contract.

2.7 SECTION 3. The director of municipal finance shall be responsible for the supervision and coordination of all activities of the department in accordance with the General Laws, town 28 by-laws, administrative codes and rules and regulations. The director of municipal finance may 29 30 also serve as the town accountant and shall be responsible for coordinating the fiscal management procedures of the office of the town treasurer, tax collector, board of assessors and town accountant, and shall be the administrator of budgeting, including financial reporting, 32 33 accountability and control, as well as an advisor on financial and programmatic implications of current and future policies to all town departments, the town Administrator and the board of 34 selectmen. The finance director shall be responsible for coordinating all financial tasks required 36 by the General Laws, and shall accomplish such tasks in accordance with the dates specified in
37 the Massachusetts department of revenue municipal calendar, as it may be amended from time to
38 time.

39 SECTION 4. Upon the effective date of this act, the position of elected tax collector in Milford shall be abolished and the term of the elected incumbent shall be terminated. The 40 appointed town accountant holding office as of the effective date of this act shall become the 41 42 director of municipal finance. The appointed, or elected, incumbents holding the offices of town treasurer and tax collector as of the effective date of this act, shall thereupon become the first 43 appointed town treasurer and tax collector, respectively. The town treasurer and tax collector 44 45 shall, subject to appropriation, maintain the same salary and benefits as they have received in their elected or appointed capacities. Notwithstanding sections 108A & 108C of Chapter 41 of 46 the General Laws and any By-Law adopted under those sections, the board of selectmen may 47 establish an employment contract with a director of municipal finance, treasurer, or tax collector 48 appointed hereunder upon the same terms and conditions, and subject to the same limitations as 49 contained within Section 108N of said chapter 41, applicable to other municipal employees as 50 designated within that section. The town treasurer and tax collector shall be employees of the 51 department of municipal finance under the direction and supervision of the director of municipal finance. Thereafter, appointments to the position of town treasurer and tax collector will be made 53 by the board of selectmen upon consultation with the town administrator and director of finance. 54

SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.

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
