Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 11 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, chapter 28 of the
- 2 acts of 2006, chapter 83 of the acts of 2010, or any other general or special law to the contrary,
- 3 the board of selectmen of the town of Arlington shall cause to be placed on the official ballot at
- 4 the 2012 annual town election the following question:
- 5 "Shall the board of selectmen of the town be authorized to grant up to 2 additional licenses for
- 6 the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises?"

- 8 SECTION 2. If a majority of votes cast in answer to the question is in the affirmative, the town
- 9 of Arlington shall be taken to have authorized the granting of up to 2 additional licenses for the
