An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Grisel Caraballo, an employee of the Department of Revenue.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Notwithstanding any special or general law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the
2 Department of Revenue shall establish a sick leave bank for Grisel Caraballo, an employee of
3 said department. Any employee of said department may voluntarily contribute one or more sick,
4 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Grisel Caraballo. Whenever Grisel
5 Caraballo terminates employment with said department or requests to dissolve the sick leave
6 bank, the balance of the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended sick leave bank. Sick
7 leave bank days may not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that
8 necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
