The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to voter identification.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 51 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out Section 45A and inserting in place thereof the following section.-
- 3 Section 45A. An applicant for registration shall prove, to the satisfaction of the Clerk or
- 4 Registrar, that he is a citizen of the United States. Such proof may be made by producing a birth
- 5 certificate or papers of naturalization for inspection, notation of which shall be made a part of the
- 6 registration of said applicant.
