An Act relative to exploratory programs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 7C of Chapter 74 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the word "program" in line 16 the following
3 words; "Students admitted to a regional vocational school exploratory program shall only be
4 charged a proportionate tuition for the actual time spent exploring the specific
5 career/occupational offering that is unavailable at the sending districts school or collaborative. "
