In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act exempting Ryan M. Charette from the maximum age requirement for appointment as a firefighter in the town of Dracut.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding chapter 31 of the General Laws or any other general or
- 2 special law to the contrary, Ryan M. Charette shall be eligible to have his name certified for
- 3 original appointment to the position of firefighter in the town of Dracut, notwithstanding his
- 4 having reached the age of 32 before taking any civil service examination in connection with that
- 5 appointment. Ryan M. Charette shall be eligible for appointment to the position of firefighter in
- 6 the town of Dracut provided that he meets all other requirements for certification and
- 7 appointment to this position.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
