An Act authorizing the City Clerk of the city of Haverhill to arrange the names of candidates for municipal elective office by random drawing.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Be it enacted, etc. as follows:
- 2 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 42 of chapter 54 of the general laws, or
- 3 any other general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the city clerk of the city of
- 4 Haverhill shall arrange the names of all candidates in a regular or special election for municipal
- 5 elective offices on ballots under the designation of the office in their order as randmonly drawn
- 6 by the clerk. The drawing of the names shall be performed on the first day, excluding Saturdays,
- 7 Sundays and legal holidays, after certification of the results of a preliminary municipal election,
- 8 if so held, or, if no preliminary municipal election is held then no later than the first Tuesday of
- 9 October.
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
