In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to the powers of city and town officials during a public health emergency.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
- 2 section 37A, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, the following section:-
- 3 SECTION 37B. The mayor of any city other than a city having a Plan D or Plan E form
- 4 of charter, the city manager of a city having a Plan D or Plan E charter, and the selectmen of a
- 5 town may, from the date of the emergency declaration issued by the Governor, dated March 10,
- 6 2020 and designated as executive order number 591, until such time as the emergency
- 7 declaration is rescinded by the governor, impose limitations on the operation of businesses
- 8 within the city or town, including but not limited to limitations on business hours, operating
- 9 procedures of types of businesses, and closing of types of businesses;
