In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act establishing a moratorium for Commonwealth charter schools.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the authority of
2 the board of education to grant commonwealth charters to an applicant pursuant to section 89 of
3 chapter 71 of the General Laws shall be suspended until September 1, 2015.
