An Act relative to sick time benefits for Frank Ray.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Frank Ray, currently an employee of the department of early education and care, shall be
- 2 credited with 300 hours of sick time, which he lost on March 14, 2008 when he changed
- 3 positions from a non-bargaining unit within the office of the state auditor to a bargaining unit
- 4 within the department of early education and care.
