An Act establishing a sick leave bank for David Senatillaka, an employee of the Department of Correction.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
2 Department of Correction shall establish a sick leave bank for David Senatillaka, an employee of  
3 the department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute to David Senatillaka  
4 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by David Senatillaka.  
5 Whenever David Senatillaka terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve  
6 the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the  
7 extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the  
8 illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by  
9 the department. This act shall take effect upon passage.
