An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Chrystal Bonner, an employee of the Executive Office of Health and Human Services.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the executive office of health and human services, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the
- 2 executive office of health and human services shall establish a sick leave bank for Chrystal
- 3 Bonner, an employee of the office. An employee of the office may voluntarily contribute 1 or
- 4 more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Chrystal Bonner.
- 5 Whenever Chrystal Bonner terminates employment with the office or requests to dissolve the
- 6 sick leave bank, the balance of the sick leave time shall be transferred to the extended illness
- 7 leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or
- 8 disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the office.
