An Act exempting the positions of police chief and police captain in the city of Leominster from the civil service law.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1: The positions of police chief and police captain in the City of Leominster shall
2 be exempt from Chapter 31 of the General Laws.

3 Section 2: This act shall take effect upon its passage.
