### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to protecting animals from abusers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 77 of chapter 272 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:- A person convicted of a violation of
- 3 section 77, 77A, 77C, 80 ½, 94 or 95 shall not harbor, own, possess, exercise control over, adopt,
- 4 or foster an animal for any length of time that the court deems reasonable for the protection of all
- 5 animals; provided, however, that the length of time shall not be less than 5 years after the
- 6 person's release from custody.
- Any person found in violation of an order incorporating the provisions of this section
- 8 may, in addition to any other punishment provided by law, be fined in an amount not exceeding
- 9 \$1,000 for each animal held in unlawful ownership or possession. Any animal involved in a
- violation described in this section shall be forfeited to the State.
