### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to use by caregivers of earned time for school closings.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Subsection (c) of section 148C of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
- 2 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out paragraphs (3) and (4) and inserting in
- 3 place thereof the following 3 paragraphs:-
- 4 (3) attend the employee's routine medical appointment or a routine medical appointment
- 5 for the employee's child, spouse, parent, or parent of spouse;
- 6 (4) address the psychological, physical or legal effects of domestic violence as defined in
- subsection (g ½) of section 1 of chapter 151A, except that the definition of employee in
- 8 subsection (a) will govern for purposes of this section; or
- 9 (5) care for the employee's child when said child's school is cancelled due to weather.
