Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 131A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the definition of "Director" the following
- 3 definition:-
- 4 "Division", the division of fisheries and wildlife.
- 5 SECTION 2. Said chapter 131A, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by adding
- 6 the following section:-
- 7 Section 8. There shall be within the division a Habitat Conservation Plan for Piping
- 8 Plover municipal technical assistance and monitoring program. Subject to appropriation, the
- 9 program shall be administered by the division to provide technical assistance and monitors to
- municipalities to conduct compliance monitoring and to ensure ongoing recreational activities
- pursuant to the division's Habitat Conservation Plan for Piping Plover. The director, or the

- director's designee, shall respond to all requests for assistance or monitors made under the
- provisions of the program within 15 days of the receipt of such requests.
