- SECTION 1. Section 25C subsection (f) of Chapter 138 of the General Laws as
- 2 appearing in the 2016 Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting after the word
- 3 "necessary", the following words: Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this
- 4 Chapter, a licensee authorized to sell alcoholic beverages at retail for off-premises consumption
- 5 may issue coupons to customers for the purchase of alcoholic beverages at prices below current
- 6 posted prices provided that the final cost to a customer is not below the retailer's invoiced cost
- 7 after applicable discounts.
