# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to first offense of juveniles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Chapter 119 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is hereby
2	amended by inserting after section 54A the following section:-
3	Section 54A <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> . Notwithstanding section 54 or any other general or special law to the
4	contrary, a delinquent child may be eligible for diversion programs administered by the court,
5	district attorney or other agency authorized to administer a diversion program at the time of a
6	finding of probable cause by a judge or clerk magistrate of the juvenile court that the delinquent
7	child violated a law of the commonwealth, notwithstanding the specified punishment; provided,
8	that the judge or clerk magistrate finds the delinquent child has not previously violated a law of
9	the commonwealth.
