So much of the recommendations of the Department of the State Treasurer (House, No. 23) as relates to motor vehicles and aircraft. Transportation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)

An Act relative to motor vehicles and aircraft.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 34A of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking, in lines 23 through 25, the following words:- “:
3 or the certificate of the state treasurer stating that cash or securities have been deposited with said
4 treasurer as provided in section thirty-four D”.

5 SECTION 2. Said chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by striking
6 section 34D in its entirety.

7 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding and general or special law to the contrary, any cash or
8 securities that have been deposited with the state treasurer shall be retained for a period of 3
9 years after the effective date of this Act. After 3 years, provided no claim is pending against the
10 applicant, any cash or securities that have been deposited may be refunded by the state treasurer.
