By Representative Mahoney of Worcester and Senator Kennedy, a joint petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) of John J. Mahoney and Robyn K. Kennedy for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Michael Grant, an employee of the Department of Correction. Public Service.

#### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Michael Grant.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Department of Correction
- 2 shall establish a sick leave bank for Michael Grant, an employee of the Department. Any
- 3 employee of the Department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation
- 4 days to the sick leave bank for use by Michael Grant. If Michael Grant terminates employment
- 5 with the Department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick
- 6 leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not
- 7 be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of
- 8 the sick leave bank as determined by the Department.
