Timilty (by vote of the town) that the town of Sharon be authorized to grant four licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises. **In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act allowing the town of Sharon to grant licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding sections 11 and 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws or
2 any other general or special law to the contrary, the licensing authority of the town of Sharon
3 may grant four (4) licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the
4 premises, under section 15 of said chapter 138. Except as otherwise provided herein, such
5 licenses shall be subject to all of said chapter 138 except section 17, provided that such licensed
6 premises must be located in the Business District A, Business District B, Business District D or
7 the Light Industrial District, as the such district may be amended from time to time, provided that
8 such use is allowed by right or by special permit in such applicable zoning district.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
