In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act authorizing the city of Everett to establish a linkage fee revolving fund.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Notwithstanding Section 53 of Chapter 44 of the General Laws, or any other
- 2 general or special law to the contrary, the
- 3 City of Everett may establish a separate fund to be known as the Linkage Fee Revolving
- 4 Fund which shall be kept separate and
- 5 apart from all other monies of the City by the City Treasurer and into which shall be

6 deposited all linkage fees received by the City

- 7 of Everett. The fund shall be used for the maintenance of streets, parks and public
- 8 recreational facilities within the City of Everett
- 9 and the Mayor shall administer the funds for said purposes. The Treasurer may invest

10 such funds in the manner authorized by

- 11 Sections 54 of said Chapter 44.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
