## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act waiving the fee for an annual caterer's license due to the COVID-19 emergency.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding section 12C of chapter 238 of the General Laws or any general or
- 2 special law to the contrary, no person shall be required to pay the annual caterer's license fee
- 3 required by said section 12C for the calendar year 2021. Any person who has paid such fee shall
- 4 be entitled to a refund of such fee from the alcoholic beverages control commission. Such refund
- 5 by the commission shall be an expenditure from monies received by the commonwealth from the
- 6 federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act or any amendment
- 7 thereto due to the COVID-19 emergency.
