(2023-2024)

An Act exempting all uniformed positions in the police department of the town of East Bridgewater from the civil service law.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, all uniformed
2 positions within the police department of the Town of East Bridgewater, including the positions
3 of police deputy chief, police lieutenant, police sergeant, and police patrol officer shall be
4 exempt from chapter 31 of the General Laws.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall not impair the civil service status of person holding a position
6 described in Section 1 on the effective date of this act.

7 SECTION 3: This act shall take effect upon its passage.
