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By Mr. Petrolati of Ludlow, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3874) of Thomas M. Petrolati (with the approval of the mayor and city council) for legislation to authorize the city of Springfield to convey certain park land and to grant a license agreement over certain park land to Unifirst Corporation. 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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand Twelve  
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### AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD TO CONVEY CERTAIN PARK LAND AND TO GRANT A LICENSE AGREEMENT OVER CERTAIN PARK LAND TO UNIFIRST CORPORATION..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. The city of Springfield, acting by and through its city council, with the approval of  
2 its mayor, may convey a small portion of a certain parcel of land in the city known as Hubbard  
3 Park, acquired for use as a public park, to UniFirst Corporation, an abutter, for the purpose of  
4 expansion of their parking lot. The property to be conveyed contains approximately .63 acres and  
5 is shown as ‘Parcel A’ on a plan entitled “Division of Land, UniFirst Corporation, 295 Parker  
6 Street, Springfield, MA” dated April 21, 2009 and prepared by Thomas Wilson & Associates,  
7 Professional Land Surveyors of East Longmeadow, MA, on file in the office of the city clerk.
- 8 SECTION 2. The city of Springfield, acting by and through its city council, with

9 the approval of its mayor, may also grant a perpetual license to enter upon Hubbard Park to  
10 UniFirst Corporation to provide UniFirst with access to construct and maintain a retaining wall  
11 to the parcel being conveyed pursuant to the authority set forth in this section and to plant trees  
12 within Hubbard Park.

13 SECTION 3. In consideration for the conveyance of the portion of park land known as 'Parcel  
14 A' and the grant of a license to enter upon Hubbard Park, as set forth in sections 1 and 2, the  
15 grantee, UniFirst Corporation, shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:

16 (1) UniFirst shall pay to the city of Springfield the sum of \$200,000 for the cost of the  
17 conveyance of said 'Parcel A' and to defray the cost of improving existing parking lots in  
18 Hubbard Park;

19 (2) UniFirst shall pay to the city of Springfield the sum of \$80,000 to defray, in part, the cost of  
20 improvements to Solutia Park, also known as Plastics Park, a parcel of land containing  
21 approximately 20 acres, which shall be acquired by the city as replacement park property to  
22 ensure a no net loss of park land;

23 (3) UniFirst shall plant no less than 80 saplings within Hubbard Park  
24 to replace trees lost by the conveyance of 'Parcel A';

25 (4) UniFirst shall construct a retaining wall at the northerly edge of its  
26 parking lot subject to the approval of the executive director of parks, buildings, and recreation  
27 management of the city of Springfield which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld;

28 (5) UniFirst shall replace the existing gates at each end of the access road on the said 'Parcel A'  
29 subject to the approval of the executive director of parks, buildings, and recreation management  
30 of the city of Springfield which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld;

31 (6) UniFirst shall not be allowed to place snow, ice, debris or other objects on the remaining city-  
32 owned Hubbard Park property; and

33 (7) UniFirst shall enter into a written license agreement with the city, and approved by the board  
34 of park commissioners of the city of Springfield, defining the terms and conditions of the license  
35 granted to UniFirst to enter upon Hubbard Park property to construct, repair and maintain the  
36 retaining wall and to plant trees.

37 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
