By Representative Binienda of Worcester and Senator Michael O. Moore, a joint petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) of John J. Binienda and Michael O. Moore for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Rebecca Paylor, an employee of the Department of Children and Families. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Rebecca Paylor, an employee of the Department of Children and Families.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish immediately a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Department of Children and Families, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Department
2 of Children and Families shall establish a sick leave bank for Rebecca Paylor, of 101 Reservoir
3 Street, Cherry Valley, Massachusetts 01611, an employee of the Department of Children and
4 Families. Any employee of the Department of Children and Families may voluntarily contribute
5 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Rebecca Paylor.
6 Whenever Rebecca Paylor terminates employment with the Department of Children and Families
7 or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be
8 transferred to the Department of Children and Families' paid sick leave bank. Sick leave bank
9 days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the
10 establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the Department of Children and Families.
