## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to equitable regional transit authority funding.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION 1. Section 35T of chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2	2016

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-

- 3 (c) Notwithstanding the foregoing, nine-tenths of the certified dedicated sales tax
- 4 revenue amount shall be credited to the Fund on behalf of the authority and the remaining one-
- 5 tenth of said amount shall be credited to the Fund for disbursement on behalf of the regional
- 6 transit authorities established in chapter 161B.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 1 shall take effect as of July 1, 2019.
