## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to establishing criminal liability for certain actions of employees of the department of chilren and families.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 51B of chapter 119 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:—
- 3 Any employee of the department shall be liable for criminal prosecution for child
- 4 endangerment by the act of screening out any report for abuse or neglect received under section
- 5 51A brought against a foster home or residential placement where the department has placed a
- 6 child without referral to law enforcement.
- 7 Such employee may also face administrative sanctions in the form of suspension, termination or
- 8 revocation of license.
