An Act Relative to electing water commissioners in the town of Harvard.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding section 69A of chapter 41 of the General Laws, or any other general or special
2 law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the town of Harvard may change the manner in which
3 their water commissioners are selected from election by ballot to appointment by the board of
4 selectmen of the town.

5 The Selectmen are hereby authorized to approve amendments which shall be within the scope of
6 the general public objectives of this petition.
