In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to the town of Milton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 272 of the acts of 1989 is hereby amended by striking out section 2
and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

3 Section 2. Notwithstanding section 97 of chapter 41 of the General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, upon the occurrence of a vacancy in the office of police 4 5 chief in the town of Milton, the Milton town administrator may fill such vacancy and all future vacancies by appointing a police chief under a contract for a term of years not to exceed 5 years. 6 Such appointment shall be made in accordance with the procedures set forth in the town by-laws. 7 Until the appointment of a police chief in accordance with these procedures, the Milton town 8 administrator may appoint a current sworn member of the police department of the town of 9 Milton as acting police chief to fill the vacancy. 10

11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
