## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Twelve

An Act Relative to the payment of fees for solemnizing Marriages in a Municipal Building in the City of Lowell.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1
- 2 "Not withstanding section 35 of chapter 262 of the General Laws, the total fee for lawfully
- 3 solemnizing and certifying amarriage shall not exceed the fee limits as set forth in said section 35
- 4 of said chapter; provided, however, that where a municipal employee of the City of Lowell who
- 5 is also a justice of the peace solemnizes a marriage in a municipal building during regular
- 6 business hours, and fees for such services shall be paid directly to the city of Lowell."
- 7 Section 2
- 8 This act shall take effect upon its passage.
