**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court  
(2019-2020)**

An Act authorizing the granting of one additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages, not to be drunk on the premises, in the City of Methuen.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding Section 17 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, the  
2           Local licensing authority of the City of Methuen may grant one additional license for the  
3           sale of all alcoholic beverages not be drunk on the premises, pursuant to Section 15 of Chapter  
4           138 to Liban D’Or, LLC located at 45 Hampshire Street in the City of Methuen, Massachusetts.  
5           The license shall be subject to all said Chapter 38 except said Section 17.

6           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage
