- 1 Ordered, That, the Bill restoring the minimum wage and providing unemployment
- 2 insurance reforms, (Senate, No. 2123) shall not be subject to amendment by the House except as
- 3 provided for herein; and be it further

- 4 Ordered, That, an amendment offered by the House committee on Ways and Means shall be in
- 5 order, provided said amendment strikes out all text after the enacting clause of Senate, No. 2123
- 6 and inserts in place thereof the text contained in House document numbered 4079, being a
- 7 duplicate of the text contained in House document numbered 4026, "An Act relative to
- 8 workforce reform; and be it further

- 9 Ordered, That, any amendment offered by the House committee on Ways and Means to Senate,
- 10 No. 2123 shall not be subject to amendment in the second degree.
