An Act relative to cider.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in line 144 the words ‘six per cent’, and inserting
- 3 in place thereof the following:- ‘eight and one half per cent’
