An Act exempting the position of apprentice lineman in the town of Norwood from the civil service law.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the position of  
2 apprentice lineman in the town of Norwood shall be exempt from chapter 31 of the General  
3 Laws.

4           SECTION 2. Nothing in this act shall impair the civil service status of a person holding  
5 the position of apprentice lineman subject to chapter 31 of the General Laws in the town of  
6 Norwood on the effective date of this act.

7           SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
