An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Miranda Marie Flanagan, an employee of the Department of Transportation.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the department of transportation, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
2 department of transportation shall establish a sick leave bank for Miranda Marie Flanagan, an  
3 employee of the department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 of  
4 more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Miranda Marie Flanagan.  
5 Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that  
6 necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.  
7 Whenever Miranda Marie Flanagan terminates employment with the department or requests to  
8 dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the  
9 extended illness leave bank.
